

New Voting Information

The Constitution of Virginia requires that you be registered to vote in the precinct in which you live, in order to be qualified to vote.

For the convenience of the citizens of Appomattox County, the Voter Registration Office located in the lower level of the Health Department is open each week Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:30 to 11:25 and 12:30 to 4:30.

If you are not currently registered to vote, and in order to vote in the November 6th General Election you must register to vote no later than 5 p.m. on Monday October 15th 2018.

If you want to avoid an extended wait in line on Election Day make sure your registration information is correct and up to date. REMEMBER YOU HAVE TO SHOW A PHOTO I.D. to vote. Call the Registrar's office if you do not have a photo I.D.

The office will also be open Saturday October 27th and Saturday November 3rd from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of absentee voting for the November 6th Election. The **last** day you can absentee vote in person for this November election is November 3rd.
