

Agricultural Exemption:

Individuals conducting agricultural blasting on their own property are not required to be certified. Property must be five (5) acres or larger in area and must be devoted to agricultural or horticultural use. If you feel you qualify for the agricultural exemption, list your driver's license number here

- ✓ Any air blast and/or ground vibration generated as a result of the functioning of the explosives shall be within limits established in NFPA 495-96 as it is referenced in the Statewide Fire Prevention Code.
- ✓ All flyrock will be confined to the blast site as it is required and defined in the Statewide Fire Prevention Code.
- ✓ Except for agricultural blasting, a bond or insurance in an amount not less than \$500,000.00 is provided and documented proof is attached to this application.

Should a permit be issued based upon this application, **it shall only be valid** within the locality issuing the Explosive Use Permit. It shall only be valid within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Town/County of Appomattox. In Appomattox County, permits can be obtained from the Office of Building and Housing.
