The Appomattox County Electoral Board met on June 8, 2016 at the Office of the Registrar. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Chuck Haney at 10 am. Those present included Chuck Haney, Frank Poynter, Mary Turner, and Sabrina Smith.

Mary reported that she attended the most recent Appomattox Town Council to discuss the effects of changing their election from May to November as lengthening the term of office from two to four years. Members of the Electoral Board will also meet with the Pamplin Town Council at its meeting on July 7th for the same purpose.

The discussion then turned to moving the voting equipment and materials for the November General and Special election. It was decided to contact area moving companies to identify the services they can provide and obtain an estimate of the cost.

The Board then identified dates for upcoming Officer of Election trainings:


- October 25

All Officers of Election will be trained at each session with different topics covered at each.


Next on the agenda was a discussion of staffing at each precinct on Election Day. The following was decided:
