The Appomattox County Electoral Board met at the Office of the General Registrar on Thursday, October 13, 2016. Chairman Chuck Haney called the meeting to order at 10 am. Also attending were Frank Poynter, Vice Chairman, and Mary Turner, Secretary.

Deputy Donnie Simpson and Sheriff Barry Letterman joined the meeting to review security plans for the upcoming November General and Special Elections. If assistance is needed at a precinct, they stressed that the first line of action is to call 911. The dispatcher will then alert the proper department. Once the list of Officers of Election is completed for this election, we will send the updated list to Deputy Simpson in the event that emergency transportation to the precincts is needed.

Minutes of the October 4th meeting of the Electoral Board were approved.

The discussion then turned to appointed additional Officers of Election. Chuck gave an update on the availability of the individuals whom he had contacted as directed at the last meeting. Those individuals who are available to attend trainings and serve were appointed.


At this point, the members of the Board allocated the ballots to the precincts as follows:

- Vera: 800 full ballots, 5 Presidential Only ballots, and 5 Federal Only ballots
- Pamplin: 1400 full ballots, 5 Presidential Only ballots, and 5 Federal Only ballots
- Chap: 600 full ballots, 5 Presidential Only ballots, and 5 Federal Only ballots
- Spout Spring: 1700 full ballots, 5 Presidential Only ballots, and 5 Federal Only ballots
- US 460: 1000 full ballots, 5 Presidential Only ballots, and 5 Federal Only ballots
- Stonewall: 1200 full ballots, 5 Presidential Only ballots, and 5 Federal Only ballots
- Courthouse: 2000 full ballots, 5 Presidential Only ballots, and 5 Federal Only ballots
- Oakville: 1500 full ballots, 5 Presidential Only ballots, and 5 Federal Only ballots
- Agee: 600 full ballots, 5 Presidential Only ballots, and 5 Federal Only ballots

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 1:15 pm.
