DISCUSSION

Chairman Carter called the recessed meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Chairman Carter welcomed Rev. Ron Davidson to the work session and stated that Mr. Davidson was here to speak with the Board regarding the committee appointments to disburse donated funds received by Gleaning for the World for the affected tornado victims.

Mr. Davidson stated that the mentioned committee would be organizing to disburse funds to the Long Term Committee to help citizens in recovering from the February 24, 2016 tornado.

There was discussion of possible fund raising events to help with the cost of recovery for those affected by the tornado.

At 7:45 p.m. Chairman Carter thanked Rev. Davidson and called for budget discussion.

Before budget discussion, Ms. Adams reminded the Board of the invitation to the upcoming tour of school facilities.

Ms. Adams also discussed the conference call that was held with Dr. Stern on why the Alert System did not work and she stated that the system did not work in other localities within the State.

After discussion, it was the consensus of the Board to have Ms. Adams contact Mr. Overstreet, County Attorney and have him write a letter to the alert system company giving them a deadline to report on the data and why it did not work.

Ms. Adams reported that staff is confirming our number of homes damaged/destroyed with FEMA and she will then call Delegate Farris.

There was lengthy discussion on the amount of cost the County has incurred due to the February 24, 2016 tornado. There was also discussion on paying the County employees for overtime incurred during the tornado.

Ms. Adams stated that she was hoping to have some revenue numbers from the Commissioner of Revenue, however, Ms. Henderson is waiting have to have someone from Campbell County to come and help with getting the needed information.

Ms. Adams reported that the VRA application had been submitted by Davenport.

Ms. Adams completed reviewing the expenditure budget and called for questions/comments.

After discussion, It was the consensus of the Board to remove \$10,000 from 7109-5618-Healing Place of Southwestern Virginia

It was the consensus of the Board to remove \$5,000 from 7109-5623-The ARC of Central Virginia

It was the consensus of the Board to remove \$1,500 from 7109-5606-Buckingham Cattleman's Association

It was the consensus of the Board to budget \$100,000 to 8105-6007-Special Projects

It was the consensus of the Board to remove \$8955 in 8105-6001- Region 2000.
