Chairman Carter called the work session to order at 7:17 p.m. and welcomed those in attendance.

Chairman Carter welcomed Mr. Bill Gillespie, MSG Consulting, who came forward and provided the Board with updated information on options that he has found favorable in addressing the issue of needed space for the Department of Social Services.

After discussion, it was the consensus of the Board to have Mr. Gillespie work with the owner of the old Thomasville building office space and get prices to see what he is offering. If this does not work out, Mr. Gillespie and Ms. Adams will work on advertising and RFP through PPEA.

Ms. Adams announced that Congressman Riggleman would be in Appomattox on March 20, 2019 between 10-10:45 a.m. He will be coming by the County Administrators office if any members of the Board would like to come and speak with him.

Ms. Adams announced that Fire Fly will be holding their open house on March 26, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. She stated that Chairman Carter would be speaking at this event.

The Board began discussion the proposed FY-20 budget.

During discussion, Ms. Adams stated that the school would be using a higher ADM number than what the State is proposing. After discussion, it was the consensus of the Board to use the ADM number that the State has provided, if the rate increases and the School receives more funding, the Board can supplement those extra funds.

After discussion of the proposed expenditures from all departments for the proposed FY-20 budget, Ms. Adams reminded the Board that the next scheduled work session would be on March 18, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.

Hearing no further discussion, Mr. Abbitt made a motion to adjourn the work session at 9:11 p.m. Mr. Hogan seconded Mr. Abbitt's motion. Chairman Carter called for a vote: Chairman Carter, aye; Mr. Abbitt, aye; Mr. Hogan, aye; Mr. Millner, aye; Mr. Moody, absent.
